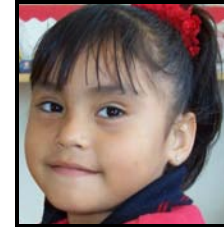

YOUR WORK WEEK:

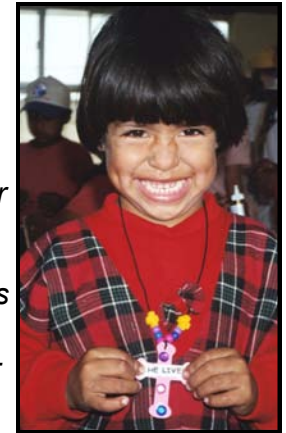
Will begin with your group's arrival on Sunday. Work at designated projects will be from Monday through Thursday with departure on Friday morning.
